

(3) Rating result

- •The average for all questions was 3.13, confirming that initiatives are being implemented to a certain extent.(Score of 3.0 or above denotes "Being implemented.")
- •The surveyed companies scored high in "Compliance with Laws and Regulations," "Safety and Health," "Quality," and "Information Security." On the other hand, they scored low in "Consideration of Environment," "Social Responsibility," and "Raising and Firmly Establishing CSR Procurement Awareness at Suppliers," pointing to challenges regarding future initiatives.
- While more than 70% of the companies have notified their employees of "CSR Procurement Guidelines" and "Obayashi Group Corporate Ethics Consultation and Reporting System," we still need to continuously promote and propagate understanding.
